Trinity Woods is a dog friendly community. However, it is important that dog owners and hosts to visiting dogs remember to be respectful of those Members who do not have dogs or may not be comfortable around dogs.

Dogs may not be in common areas unless they are being led outside/inside and they MUST be on a leash and controlled at all times. Members are required to clean up after their pet. If your dog has an accident indoors in your home or in a common area, you are responsible for cleaning it up. Dogs are not allowed to bark continuously and disrupt other members. Finally, owners are always expected to pick up and dispose of pet waste in the pet station provided outside around the community, not in indoor trashcans or the garbage chutes in Crestwood. We love dogs at Trinity Woods and love it when their owners properly take care of them.
